Twenty-four Empty Bowls were donated at our July, bringing our total for 2018 to 105. We still have a long way to go to meet our goal of 300 by our February meeting! Only 12 members have contributed Empty Bowls so far this year. As a club, we have consistently done better. Members donated eight Beads of Courage boxes in July. 




