Carl will be teaching us how to make a really pretty Salt/Pepper mill, a winged bowl that looks like a stingray and a textured and decorated bracelet. Carl's demo will be a hybrid (resin and wood) project that will spur ideas for years to come.



Classes are scheduled as follows:

Friday, October 19: Gorgeous Salt or Pepper mill:



This is a very distinctive mill that you will be proud to use in your kitchen, Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners and special occasions with your friends and family. The salt mill can be used for either pepper or salt as the unit is ceramic rather than the traditional metal. Cost of this class is \$100 and includes materials to make one 10" Salt mill.

Saturday, October 20: Sting Ray bowl with chop sticks

Carl will show us how to turn a square blank into a round bowl with wings that looks like its flying through the water. You can wow you friends and family when you serve your next fancy meal in a set of these that you made yourself. Cost of this class is \$100 and includes wood for one bowl and a set of chop sticks.



Sunday October 21: Wooden bracelet

These are fun projects that are great gifts for any occasion. Christmas is just around the corner and these would make quick work for those hard to please or unexpected guests that always pop in at the last minute. Cost of this class is \$100 and includes wood for two bracelets per participant.
