# **Empty Bowls and Beads of Courage by Lou Boudreaux**

The annual North Texas Food Bank Empty Bowls lunch will be from 11:00 AM until 1:00 PM on March 11, 2016 at the Myerson Symphony Center. A \$40 admission ticket allows attendees to sample a wide range of soups and bread prepared by some of Dallas' best chefs, and chose a ceramic or wood bowl made by Dallas area potters and wood turners. DAW members are encouraged to attend this event whose proceeds will provide thousands of meals for the needy served by the North Texas Food Bank. 2016 was a very good year for Empty Bowls, 32 people contributed a total of 360 bowls for this worthwhile charity. John Holderman was the largest contributor with 73 bowls. Sixtyeight bowls were donated at our January meeting.


