Empty Bowls and Beads of Courage-Lou Boudreaux

Sixteen Empty Bowls were donated by five members at our September meeting. This brings the total for 2019 to 98 bowls from 16 members. DAW Empty Bowls contributions are less than one third of our 300 bowl goal, with 67 of the bowls from only four members. We have only three more meetings after this month to reach the 300-bowl level we have achieved over the last ten years.

Nine Beads of Courage boxes were contributed by six DAW members in September, giving a total of 65 for the year. Members have completed 43 if the 65 BoC kits provided by DAW in 2019. It is hoped that all these kits will be completed by November so we can donate them to Children's Hospital for the Christmas season.
