I taught group turning classes at the Rockler Woodworking and Hardware for a few years in Richardson, TX. Susan Clewell won the entry ticket drawing and won a club membership and two holiday party tickets for the 2019 event (\$95.00 value).



The Christmas Party revenue raised close to \$8300.00 through tickets sales and auction results. After expenses the club netted the club \$2200.00


I will present a short income and expense report for the club members on Thursday and then will introduce the new Treasurer, Mike Sahl.
